Free Activities

There's a number of ways to explore the peninsula from both land and sea. If you would rather take things at your own pace, there's plenty of day walks and drives, great fishing spots, and some fantastic paddling areas to ensure you enjoy some of the best scenery in the world. Pack a picnic and get out there. As always check weather forecasts, and take plenty of provisions if heading out for an extended amount of time.




SEA KAYAKING

Freycinet is a great place for sea kayaking. Summer sea breezes can be strong on hot days, so early starts are recommended and it is good to get the latest weather reports before heading out. Most of the paddling is in Great Oyster Bay. The outside coastline of the peninsula is only for experienced paddlers as there are few, if any, take-outs (all cliffs) on the sea-side of the peninsula.



SURFING & WINDSURFING

When the winds and swell are right Friendly Beaches offers great surfing. Summer sea breezes can also create great windsurfing conditions in Great Oyster Bay and Coles Bay.




ROCK CLIMBING

Freycinet National Park has a number of great granite climbing areas. The highest concentration of climbs is centred around whitewater wall, sea cliff climbs. There is a climbers camp near whitewater wall, inside the national park. Access is by a 4wd track or vehicle with good clearance.

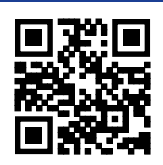



NSP
